

Contributors' Terms and Conditions

- 1.1 These Contributors' Terms and Conditions apply, along with the Legal Notices and Terms of Use published at <<http://www.freepint.com/legal.htm>> (together the "**Terms**") to any text, information, data, graphics, software or other materials ("**Contributions**") you (the FreePint Web site user) post to the FreePint Web site ("**Site**") or submit to us (Free Pint Ltd) for inclusion on any area of the Site, including in any chat room or forum, or for any advertisement, article, newsletter or report. In these Terms we refer to any such posting or submission as "**Submission**".
- 1.2 When you Submit a Contribution you must ensure it complies with the Author Guidelines published at <<http://www.freepint.com/author/>>. By Submitting a Contribution you will be deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by the Terms for that Contribution.
- 1.3 If you Submit a Contribution to the Site you must make sure that you either own all the copyright, database rights, trade marks, patents, moral rights (such as rights to attribution or to object to derogatory treatment) or any other similar intellectual property rights existing anywhere whether now or in future ("**IPRs**") in the Contribution and/or have all relevant permissions and licences to allow you to agree to these Terms and Submit the Contribution on these Terms (including allowing us to use the Contribution as set out in these Terms).
- 1.4 We will not expect you to give us ownership of any Contribution. However, if you make a Contribution we will need to be able to use it freely. You (or your licensors) retain ownership of all IPRs in the Contribution, but you waive all moral rights and allow us to use all or any part of the Contribution in any manner we deem appropriate at any time (whether now or in the future), including (whether or not in return for payment) publishing it or otherwise distributing it on the Site or on another website or in electronic, paper or other format, commenting on it, translating it, including it in other materials or in collections or archives of other information or materials, amending or changing it or using it in a shorter or longer form, allowing third parties to use it for any purpose and otherwise copying or reproducing it anywhere and in any form. If we edit your Contribution or otherwise add to or amend it we will use reasonable efforts to obtain your approval of any such changes. Other than in the case of reports (when we will enter a separate agreement with you) we are not obliged to pay you for use of the Contribution as permitted in these Terms.
- 1.5 You must ensure that your Submission and our use of the Contribution as permitted in these Terms do not infringe the IPRs of any other person or party, including any company or other legal entity ("**Third Party**") or breach any right or duty owed to any Third Party, or contain any unlawful, defamatory, blasphemous, obscene, harmful or immoral content or content

that might cause any Third Party to break any local or foreign law or obligation or suffer any damage, loss or offence. You must tell us immediately if you are or become aware of any Third Party who might believe your Contribution causes them loss, damage or offence or to breach legal or other obligations. You must reimburse us for any costs, expenses, damages or losses we incur as a result of a Third Party claiming that all or part of your Contribution infringes its IPRs or any other of its rights, or is defamatory or otherwise causes loss or damage or otherwise breaches this section 1.5.

- 1.6 You will ensure that all Contributions are your own original work and have not been fully or partially published (whether or not for payment) prior to their Submission to us.
- 1.7 We may check all Contributions to monitor compliance with these Terms and may remove any Contributions which we feel may breach these Terms or the spirit of these Terms.
- 1.8 If you re-use or allow any other party to re-use all or a substantial part of your IPRs in a Contribution that is an article or newsletter you shall include with reasonable prominence the statement "This article first appeared in [description], a Free Pint Limited publication".
- 1.9 These Terms are subject to English law and you and we agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts in relation to any dispute arising out of or relating to them.
- 1.10 Nothing in these Terms intends to:
 - (a) create any partnership or joint venture between you and us; or
 - (b) confer any rights on any Third Party.
- 1.11 When wording such as "including" is used in these Terms it is simply intended to provide examples and not to limit the scope of any Term.
